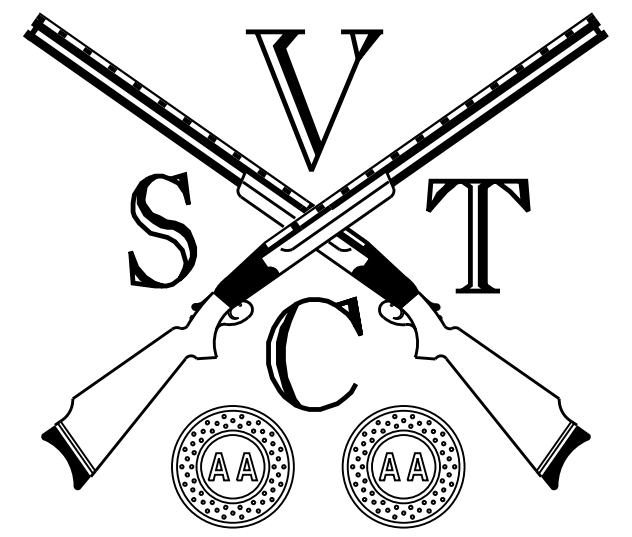

I would just like to re-emphasize a few of the concerns that have been raised
in the past and remind people to look after the Victoria S & T Club as your
"second home" and to keep it as nice and presentable as you would your own

- ★ One of the MOST important things to do is SIGN-IN the log book when
- ★ arriving at the club. This helps with proper accounting of targets and
money for the rounds shot. (This point deserves 2 stars, it is THAT important)
- ★ Remember, after shooting to ALWAYS re-fill target machines for the
people that come along after you and to pick up your hulls from the
ranges (this has been a problem with for the lawn mower).
- ★ ALWAYS remember to finish filling out the log book before leaving the club.
When paying for your rounds with cash or check, please place the money in a
sealed envelope and write your name and the amount of rounds on the outside
of it & place it in the box. You do NOT need to use an envelope for coupons.
